High Efficiency Toilet Rebate Program

Rebate is **\$150**, or the cost of the toilet, whichever is less.

You qualify with a new... High Efficiency Toilet (1.28-gpf) or Ultra High Efficiency Toilet (1.0-gpf)

- ◆ The toilet(s) must be installed at a location served by the FLMWC.
- ◆ The toilet(s) must be rated at a maximum of 1.28 gallons per flush (gpf).
Look for the blue and green EPA WaterSense label.
- ◆ The rebate does not apply to installation charges.
- ◆ This rebate offer effective while funds are available.
- ◆ An on-site inspection by a FLMWC representative may be required to verify installation.
- ◆ Rebates are only available for replacing older, existing toilets that use 3.5-gallons per flush(gpf) or more. Rebates are not available for the replacement of another low consumption (1.6-gpf) or high efficiency (1.28-gpf) toilet.



Procedure

1. Purchase and install your toilet. To find out how the various toilet makes and models are rated in terms of flushing performance, go to www.map-testing.com. The higher the MaP rating, the better the flush.
2. Complete this form and attach the **original** sales receipt or itemized plumber's invoice showing the toilet model and date of purchase. Return to the FLMWC office for processing. Your original receipt will be returned.
3. Allow four weeks from the date the application was received to obtain a rebate.
4. Residents can recycle old toilets at the Ben Lomond Transfer Station.

This program provides financial assistance to customers wishing to replace older, higher-water-use toilets with high efficiency toilets in their home. Installation of the toilets is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is the determination of the adequacy and compatibility of their existing plumbing system.
